But simultaneously we are to emphasize that owing to:

- a) The regular improvements that were gradually introduced in the spiritual and pedagogical condition of our institute,
- b) The prevailing economic crisis with our brethren in Poland,
- c) The continual decrease of the subsidies allotted by the J. D. C. that were reduced to nearly zero in comparison with our monthly budget,

our financial position grew worse and so intricate that there is almost no possibility of commencing the new school-year without any future prospects of obtaining permanent and substantial aid from the Joint Distribution Committee.
