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Latin

Etymology

Can be construed as *līveō* (“I am of a bluish color or livid; envy”) + *-idus*, but more at *līveō*.

Pronunciation

- (*Classical*) IPA^(key): /ˈliː.ʊi.dus/, [ˈliːʊɪɖʊs]
- (*Ecclesiastical*) IPA^(key): /ˈli.vi.dus/, [ˈliːviɖus]

Adjective

lividus (*feminine* **livida**, *neuter* **lividum**, *superlative* **lividissimus**, *adverb* **lividē**); *first/second-declension adjective*

- (*color*) leaden, bluish, blue
- (*especially, produced by beating, bruising, etc.*) black and blue, livid
- (*transferred sense*) making livid, *that is* deadly
- (*figuratively*) envious, invidious, spiteful, malicious
