

## Some Manuscripts of the Zohar Judy Barrett

*Before the Zohar was first printed in the 1550s in Italy, parts circulated in manuscripts. Many hundreds of these are extant.<sup>1</sup> However, the field of Zohar studies desperately needs a central, online, and open access repository for all of them in digitized form.<sup>2</sup> Pending fulfillment of this desideratum, here are listed some of the most important manuscripts (mss; sing. ms.) and their use for the Pritzker edition.<sup>3</sup> Those lacking an abbreviation (the first 47) are alphabetized by Collection name; after that alphabetization follows the Abbreviations.*
